
Completing Homework with Adobe Reader

Adobe Acrobat Reader DC is a free program that you can use to complete your homework digitally, either by using the 'Fill and sign' tool (Method 1) or the fillable PDF format (Method 2).

If you do not already have Adobe Reader installed, you can download it from https://get.adobe.com/reader/ (we recommend unchecking the optional offers)

Method 1 - Using the 'Fill and sign' tool

This method works for plain PDF files (i.e. files that do NOT have the [Fillable] tag)


1) Open the saved file with Adobe Acrobat Reader DC



2) Click on the 'Fill and Sign' icon on the toolbar near the top of the screen




3) A second toolbar should appear; click on the leftmost button to add text.




4) Switch to Japanese input as required.




5) For multiple choice questions, select the ' \checkmark ' button and click on your answer



6) When you are done, save the file (File > Save As...) and add your name to the file name


We recommend saving to an easy to find location like your desktop, or creating a new folder for your course materials.




Method 2 - Fillable PDF Format

Use this method for files with the [Fillable] tag.


1) Open the saved file with Adobe Acrobat Reader DC




2) Type your answers directly into the available fields



3) Switch to Japanese input as required.



4) When you are done, save the file (File > Save As...) and add your name to the file name
